In continuation to the guidelines given in the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited above, regarding the implementation of centralized web based software, the following additional Guidelines may be noted regarding procurement of Biometric device, additional hardware, Pre-print stationeries, BSNL connectivity.

**Connectivity:**

- Proposed connectivity is MPLS over VPN which require a separate telephone line for each location.
- During the pilot test at Pallavapuram and other 5 ULBs in the fringe area, it was observed that, the bandwidth requirement for office location is 2 Mbps and for Collection center is 1 Mbps. Hence to start the implementation, it is decided to follow the same.
- Corporations and ULBs having large volume of data may change their plan to premium plan if needed.
- As a common terms and condition/ agreement for all ULBs is under preparation for connectivity, SMS service, centralized help desk for this project with Ms.BSNL all the Executive Authorities are requested

to keep the filled in application ready to submit(separate application for office, external collection center, GH – if any )

- Regarding connectivity utilization, individual billing will be raised for all ULBs
- The central Router maintenance and its connectivity will be equally shared by all ULBs.

**Bio-matric Device:**

- The details of Bio-metric device supplied by ELCOT to the pilot Location - Pallavapuram Municipality is enclosed here with. The interface software for this device has been procured by the Pallavapuram Municipality and it is integrated in the centralized web based software(CWBS). Hence it is requested to procure only the Bio-metric device. No need to procure the application interface software(API) again. (Please mention Pallavapuram reference in your quotation.)

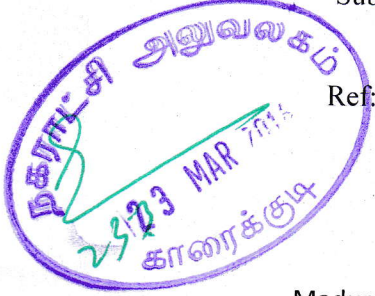
