ORDER:-

In the Government Order read above, Government have sanctioned a sum of **Rs.161,50,00,000/- (Rupees One hundred and Sixty One crore and fifty lakh only)** as grants to Million Plus Cities of Tamil Nadu for improving conservation, supply and management of water and efficient solid waste management measures for the year 2020-2021 under the award of 15th Central Finance Commission.

Hence, sanction is hereby accorded for the release of **Rs.161,50,00,000/- (Rupees One hundred and Sixty One crore and fifty lakh only)** as the first installment of Grant for the year 2020-2021 under the award of 15th Central Finance Commission to **Million Plus Cities** (i.e) Greater Chennai Corporation, Coimbatore, Madurai and Tiruchirappalli Municipal Corporations as detailed below:-

The Commissioners of Greater Chennai Corporation, Coimbatore, Madurai and Tiruchirappalli are instructed to develop year wise target for the period 2020-2025 strictly as per parameters for their city, as laid down in Annexure 5.6 of 15th Central Finance Commission Report and ensure that all the parameters are achieved and grant are availed in time.

Since, the government have requested the CMA to furnish the Utilization certificate towards utilization of funds now sanctioned, the Corporation Commissioners are requested to submit the report in the prescribed format for the receipt of the above grant amount.
