<b>I. Governor Address - 2021-2022</b>		
1	87/B2	Modern solid and liquid waste management technologies and equipment will be fully deployed to ensure a safe and hygienic working environment for sanitary workers. (Governor Address-2021-22, Para No. 59) The maintenance of the sewage systems will be fully mechanized. (Revised Budget Speech-2021-22-P.No.71).

1	286/B2	27 cities with a population of above one lakh will be fully covered with underground sewerage systems. (Revised Budget Speech-2021-22-P.No.71).
2	295 B2	Those who contribute significantly towards such works in Namakku Naame Thittam will be awarded the Hon'ble Chief Minister's Special Award every year. (Revised Budget Speech-2021-22-P.No.73).
3	296 B2	Online provision of services to all citizens would be ensured through the Makkal Sevaiyil Managaratchi and Namadhu Sevaiyil Nagaratchi schemes. Revised Budget Speech-2021-22-P.No.73)
4	299 B2	An integrated bus stand cum commercial centre will be established in Tiruchirapalli with the financial assistance of TUFIDCO. Revised Budget Speech-2021-22-P.No.74).
<b>III. Hon'ble Minister Announcement - 2021-2022</b>		
1	1278	Based on the Budget announcement, a new scheme "Kalaingar Nagarpura Membattu Thittam" for providing basic amenities like Community halls, Markets, Modern Libraries will be implemented in all Municipalities and Town Panchayats with an allocation of Rs.1000 crore.

2	1279	"Namakku Naame Thittam" will be implemented to provide basic amenities like Water body rejuvenation , formation of parks, Recreation and sports facilities, Planting trees, Upgradation of schools, Public health centres, knowledge centres, providing Roads and Street light facilities in all Corporations including Greater Chennai, Municipalities, Town panchayats with an allocation of Rs.300 crore.
3	1280	With a vision to improve the livelihood of urban poor, "Nagarpura Velaivaippu Thittam " will be implemented in 2 zones in Chennai Corporation, One zone in each 14 Corporations, in 7 regions each one Municipalities , in 37 Districts each one Town Panchayat at an estimated amount of Rs.100 crore.
4	1281	At present, totally 73.57 lakh Households are available in 14 Corporations, 121 Municipalities and 528 Town Panchayats, of which 38.93 lakh Households have been provided with House service connection (HSC). It is proposed to provide 4 lakhs Functional House service tap connections in 14 corporations &121 Municipalities and 1 lakh connections in 528 TPs with source augmentation, storage facilities, pumping main and distribution main during the current year.
5	1282	It is proposed to take-up rejuvenation of 150 no of water bodies at a cost of Rs.300 crore in 14 Corporations & 121 Municipalities. 450 Water bodies in TPs at a cost of Rs.160 crore will be rejuvenated.
6	1283	200 new toilets will be constructed at a cost of Rs.50 Crore and 300 toilets will be retrofitting at a cost of Rs.15 crore in Corporations and Municipalities. 100 new toilets will be constructed at a cost of Rs.25 Crore and 150 toilets will be retrofitted at a cost of Rs.7.50 crore in all Town Panchayats. Every household in urban areas would be provided access to a toilet and the practice of open defecation truly eliminated. (Revised Budget Speech-2021-22-P.No.71).

7	1284	In order to clear the legacy waste, during the current year Biomining work will be taken up in Madurai and Trichirapalli corporations at an estimated cost of Rs.71 Crore (for removal of 9.12 lakh cu.m of legacy waste) and in 8 Municipalities namely Coonoor, Sirkali, Thoirutharaipoondi, Manapparai, Devakottai, Chinnamanur, Puliyanudi and Viruthunagar at an estimated cost of Rs 13 crore (for the removal of 1.66 Lakh cu mt of legacy wastes. Similarly, Bio mining works will be taken up in 25 Town Panchayats at an estimated cost of Rs.20 crore for removal of 2.45 Lakh cu.m of legacy waste.
8	1285	2,220 Electric Vehicles will be purchased at a cost of Rs.71 crore for the next 2 years to carry out Solid Waste Management in Town Panchayats to reduce the work load of Sanitary workers 1494 Electric Vehicles and 29 LVM will be purchased at a cost of Rs.35.00 crore.
9	1286	G.O. Issued.  TP-2 For improvement of 452 parks tender received on 16.09.2021 and under scrutiny by Commissioner of Town Panchayats .  MC-2 Report awaited from Director of Municipal Administration Govt letter no.19313/MC2/ 2021, dated 21.10.2021
10	1287	Conversion of Earthen roads in to All Weather Roads in Corporations, Municipalities and Town Panchayats.It is the vision of the Government to convert all Earthen roads as All Weather Roads. In the Budget 2021-22, it has been announced that all earthen roads in Corporations, Municipalities and Town Panchayats will be upgraded. Based on the announcement, all the earthen roads will be upgraded as Black Top (BT) roads/ Cement Concrete (CC) roads/ Paver block roads under various schemes in a phased manner.It is proposed to convert 400 Kms length of earthen roads as Black Top (BT) roads/ Cement Concrete (CC) roads at a cost of Rs.300 crore in Corporations and Municipalities.It is proposed to convert 500 Kms length of earthen roads as Black Top (BT) roads/ Cement Concrete (CC) roads at a cost of Rs.325 crore in Town Panchayats.

11	1288	<p>Restoration of roads damaged due to UGSS and WSIS pipe line laying works</p> <p>The roads were damaged due to execution of Underground sewerage Scheme and Water Supply Improvement Schemes. Also, due to natural calamities and during monsoon periods roads were eroded and damaged. it is imperative to restore these damaged roads. 500 kms of roads will be taken up for restoration at a cost Rs 250 crore in Corporations and Municipalities.194 roads works covering length of 292 KMs in 157 Town Panchayats and 11 bridges in 7 Town Panchayats at a cost of Rs.200.70 crore are proposed with the financial assistance under NABARD.</p>
12	1289	<p>Street Light Conversion of LED lights &amp; New Lights in Corporations , Municipalities and Town Panchayats Totally 7.87 lakh of streetlights are available in Corporations and Municipalities. Out of which, 4.58 lakh Street lights were converted as Energy efficient lights. Similarly, In 528 TPs, 4.55 lakh street lights are available. Out of which 96,000 lights were converted as Energy efficient lights. 3.29 Lakh existing streetlights in Avadi, Nagercoil, Hosur, Dindigul corporations and 86 Municipalities and 1.85 lakh street light in Town Panchayats will be replaced with Energy efficient lights with a Central control &amp; Monitoring system will be established at an estimated cost of Rs.477 crore. Further 1.50 lakh new Energy efficient street lights will be installed at a cost of Rs.230 crore in extended areas and newly added areas of Corporations, Municipalities and Town Panchayats based on the requirement.</p>
13	1290	<p>Development of Modern Crematorium in Corporations, Municipalities and Town Panchayats At present, 7 Electrical crematorium, 95 Gasifier crematorium are functioning in Corporations / Municipalities. Similarly, 31 Gasifier crematorium and 2130 burial ground are functioning in 528 Town Panchayats.50 Nos. of Crematoriums will be taken up at a cost of Rs. 75 crore in Corporations and Municipalities.25 Nos. Crematoriums will be taken up in Town Panchayats at a cost of Rs. 37.50 crore.</p>

14	1291	Redevelopment and construction of Markets in Corporations , Municipalities and Town Panchayats. There are 106 weekly market and 224 Daily markets are functioning in Corporations/ Municipalities. Similarly, 302 markets are functioning in 528 Town Panchayats.It is proposed to take up the construction of new markets at a cost of Rs. 50 crore and re-development of 20 existing market will be improved at a cost of Rs. 65.00 crore in Corporations and Municipalities.It is proposed to take up the construction of 10 shandys at a cost of Rs. 50 crore in 10 town panchayts.
15	1292	50 Libraries and Intellectual Centers will be established in ULBS at an estimated cost of Rs.100.00 crore for those who prepare for competitive exams and Job searchers.
16	1294	Water supply Improvement Works in Tiruvarur and Karur Municipality Water Supply improvement work will be taken up in Tiruvarur Municipality with an estimated cost of Rs.88 crore and in Karur Municipality with an estimate cost of Rs.63crore
17	1295	Implementation of Under ground sewerage scheme Under ground sewerage scheme will be taken up in Hosur Corporation with an estimated cost of Rs.454 croreUnder ground sewerage scheme will be taken up for the added areas of Thoothukudi Corporation with an estimated cost of Rs.510 crore.Under ground sewerage scheme will be taken up for implementation in Aruppukottai and Mannarkudi Municipalities.
18	1320	Upgradation of Municipalities to Corporations, Town panchayats to municipalities and Expansion of boundaries of corporations/municipalities.
